Nature NB, Fredericton office, is seeking a bilingual Nature Educator for the summer months. The Nature Educator will work with our Summer Youth Nature Camp Program. The position will involve researching nature education themes and designing programs at various sites. The educator will also be responsible for coordinating, implementing and evaluating these programs. The Nature Educator will supervise overnight campers and be willing to perform any other tasks required for the nature camp program. A primary responsibility for the position will be the coordinator and supervision of the nature education position.

Requirements:

- Aged 15-30, and must be a student this year and next
- Bilingual (French and English)

Qualifications:

- Experience in wildlife biology and/or environmental sciences
- Experience working with children and/or a background in education
- Ability to work in a team atmosphere and ability to work under pressure and meet deadlines

- Excellent public communication skills, both written and verbal
- CPR and First Aid Certification required and criminal record check for selected candidate
