



M.Sc. project in Forest Bird Ecology

As part of an ongoing study on the effects of forestry on wildlife, we are looking for a candidate to conduct a masters project on the response of two woodpecker species to experimental harvesting in northern New Brunswick. The ideal candidate would have prior experience in radio-telemetry of wild animals and the ability to work independently in remote locations.
