

## The Mary Majka Scholarship Application Form

The Mary Majka Scholarship Fund was established with the intent to further youth engagement with nature and our natural heritage. This scholarship is open to New Brunswick students from middle school to those attending an undergraduate program. Awards will be granted on a yearly basis ranging from \$250 to \$1000. Deadline is March 31<sup>st</sup>.

## All applicants please note:

- An application MUST be received by Nature NB by March 31st 2023;
- An application must respond to ALL sections for the application in order for it to be considered by the committee.

Scholarships will be awarded to a person who is or will be studying in the field of natural sciences with a focus on nature conservation, and has a demonstrated history of interest and activity in nature.

Applicants may fall into one of three categories:

- High school graduates, upon entering a post-secondary education program focusing on nature conservation;
- Post-secondary students who are already enrolled in a post-secondary education program focused on nature conservation; or
- Students in middle or high school, for a project focused on nature conservation.

In all instances, consideration by the Scholarship Fund Committee will be in accordance with the original MARY MAJKA SCHOLARSHIP FUND mandate. Successful applicants will focus EXCLUSIVELY on programs or projects that deal with nature conservation.

Examples of programs or projects that will not be considered for funding: studies in human or veterinary medicine, engineering, biochemistry, agriculture, kinesiology, and any other program that does not focus on issues that deal with nature conservation
