Machias Seal Island (MSI) CBCs

Ralph Eldridge, one of the lighthouse keepers on Machias Seal Island, has undertaken "real Christmas Bird Counts" on December 25 in years that he has been posted to MSI during the CBC Count Period. Ralph's data collection started in 1991; an earlier count was done in 1976.

Unfortunately, several years worth of data from this rather unique CBC area (who else reports a Northern Fulmar or notes many alcids on a CBC?) has (so far) been lost. Based on correspondence with Ralph, the following is a best estimate of when counts occurred and which counts have data.

1976 - data ok 1991 - data ok 1992 - data ok 1993 - data ok 1997 - data lost 1999 - data lost 2001 - data lost 2003 - data lost 2005 - data lost 2007 - data ok 2010 - data ok 2011 - data ok 2013 - data ok 2015 - data lost 2017 - data lost 2019 - data ok 2021 - data ok 2023 - data ok

18 counts in total with data lost from 7 of them.

Note that the three counts in 1999, 2001, and 2003 are a bit speculative. Based on Ralph's work schedule, he estimated that there would have been counts in about three additional years after 1996 and that spacing seemed most appropriate.
